








FAFSA Completion

Post High School Graduation Intentions





Math Performance

17% of Caswell County 3-8 graders earn college-and-career-ready scores in Math, below the rural - non-metro county average of 30%.

Caswell County has met the goal for **Pre-K enrollment**. (Goal: **75%**). **Peer:** 71.0% | **State:** 57.2% 2024

Caswell County Traditional Public Schools students:

18.5% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in reading** in 2024. 486 more needed to meet state goal of **73%**.

Peer: 24.5% | **State:** 29.8%

16.7% of 3-8 graders **earned college-and-career-ready scores in math** in 2024. 618 more needed to meet state goal of **86%**.

Peer: 30.3% | State: 36.5%

38.0% of students were **chronically absent from school** in 2024. 602 fewer needed to meet state goal of **11%**. **Peer:** 27.7% | **State:** 25.7%



Caswell County has a **student-to-school counselor ratio** of **338:1** compared to **332:1** in peer counties. 2024

Pathways to College and Career

Students in traditional public schools completed **418 Career & Technical Education (CTE) credentials and 80 concentrations. 65 (15.6%) of credentials were industry-valued** in 2023. The top three CTE concentrations: Agricultural, Food, & Natural Resources; Manufacturing; and Human Services.



Less than 10 (<5%) high school students took at least one AP, IB, or CIE exam. State: 16.8% (2023).



64 (39.8%) high school graduates participated in **Career & College Promise programs. State:** 36.0% (2024).
